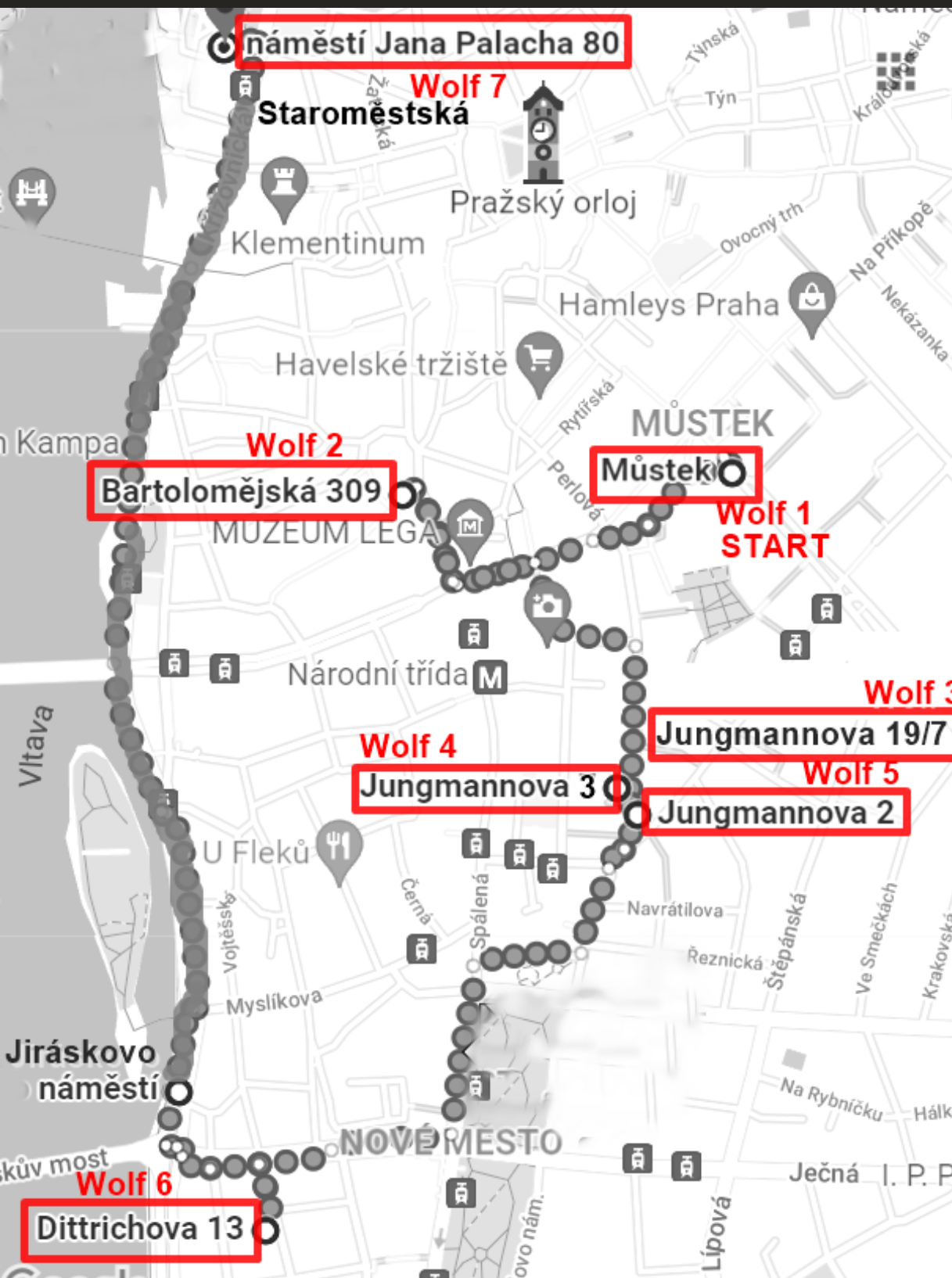

Wolves can't talk, can they? Or can they? Of course, non-human animals can use language. They have vast repertoires of verbal and non-verbal communication at their disposal. They can talk, even if human animals can hardly understand them. But non-human animals cannot produce discourse, at least not when we see discourse as systematically articulated knowledge frameworks. This inability to produce discourses generates structural power imbalances, which places non-human animals in a fundamentally disadvantageous position. This imbalance is only worsened by the access that human animals have to advanced technologies.

Wolf Talks is an arts-based research project that questions the power dynamics of the discursive-material relationships between human and non-human animals. Go on a WOLF WALK, and visit the twelve wolf-and-cat-face collage photographs, located at 12 different places in Prague. On each location, you can listen to a Wolf Talks sound fragment (connected with the photograph through a QR code), where a wolf will speak to you. WOLF WALK



Start at Wolf 1 in the underpass of Můstek metro station, Václavské náměstí, Prague 1.

Walk via Václavské náměstí, Jungmannovo nám., Národní, Na Perštýně.

Find Wolf 2 in Pub Zázemí at Bartolomějská 309, Prague 1.

Walk via Na Perštýně, Národní, Jungmannova.

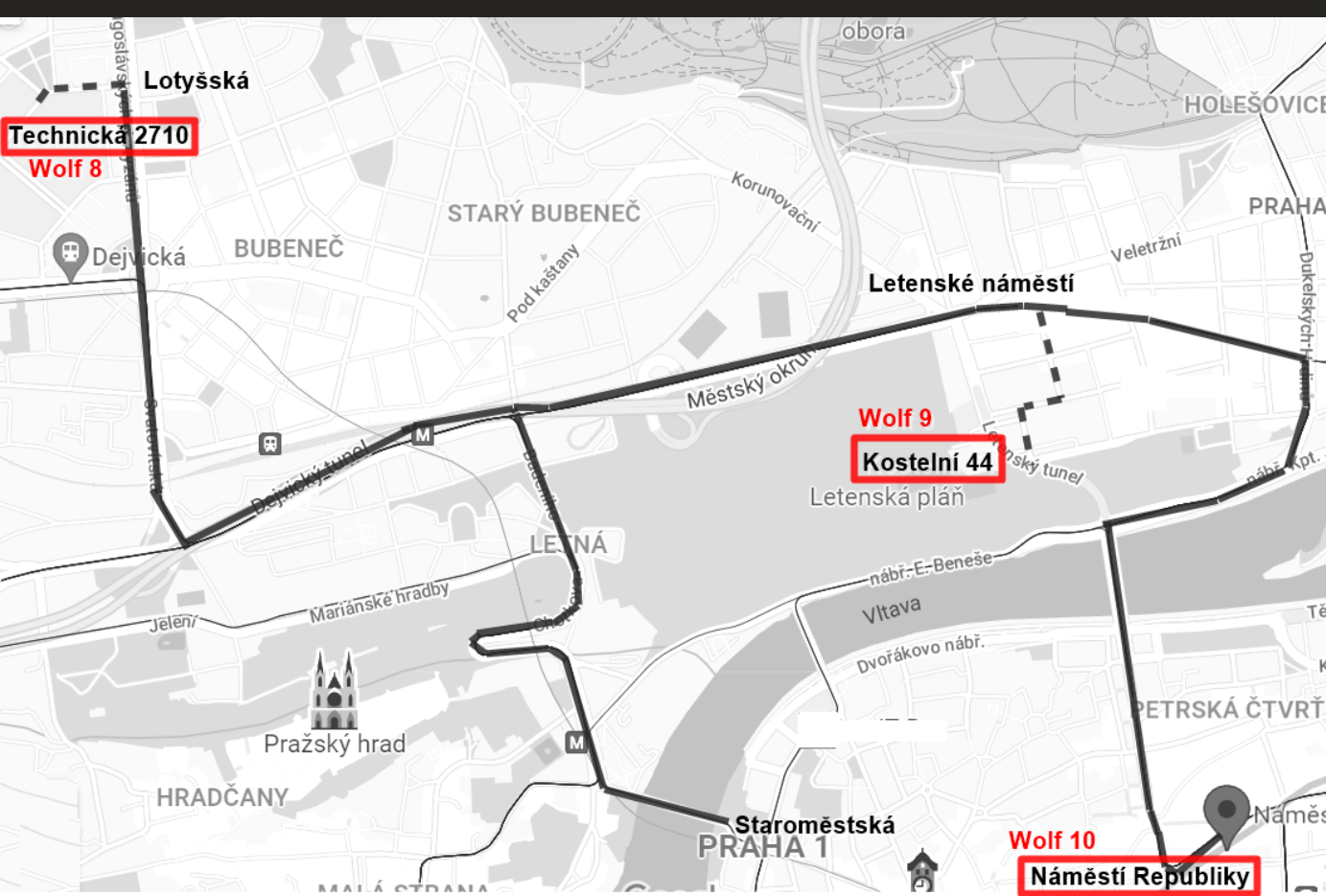
Find Wolf 3 in Fotograf Gallery* at Jungmannova 7, Wolf 4 in Hvězdný Bazar at Jungmannova 3, and Wolf 5 in Česká Spořitelna at Jungmannova 2.

Walk via Vodičkova, Karlovo náměstí, Resslova to Dittrichova.

Find Wolf 6 in Tranzit at Dittrichova 13.

Walk via Resslova to riverside, take a tram 17 or 27 (direction Malostranská) to Staroměstská tram stop.

Find Wolf 7 in the foyer of UMPRUM at nám. Jana Palacha 80.



Take a tram 18 (direction Nádraží Podbaba) to Lotyšská tram stop and walk via Velfíkova, Studentská.

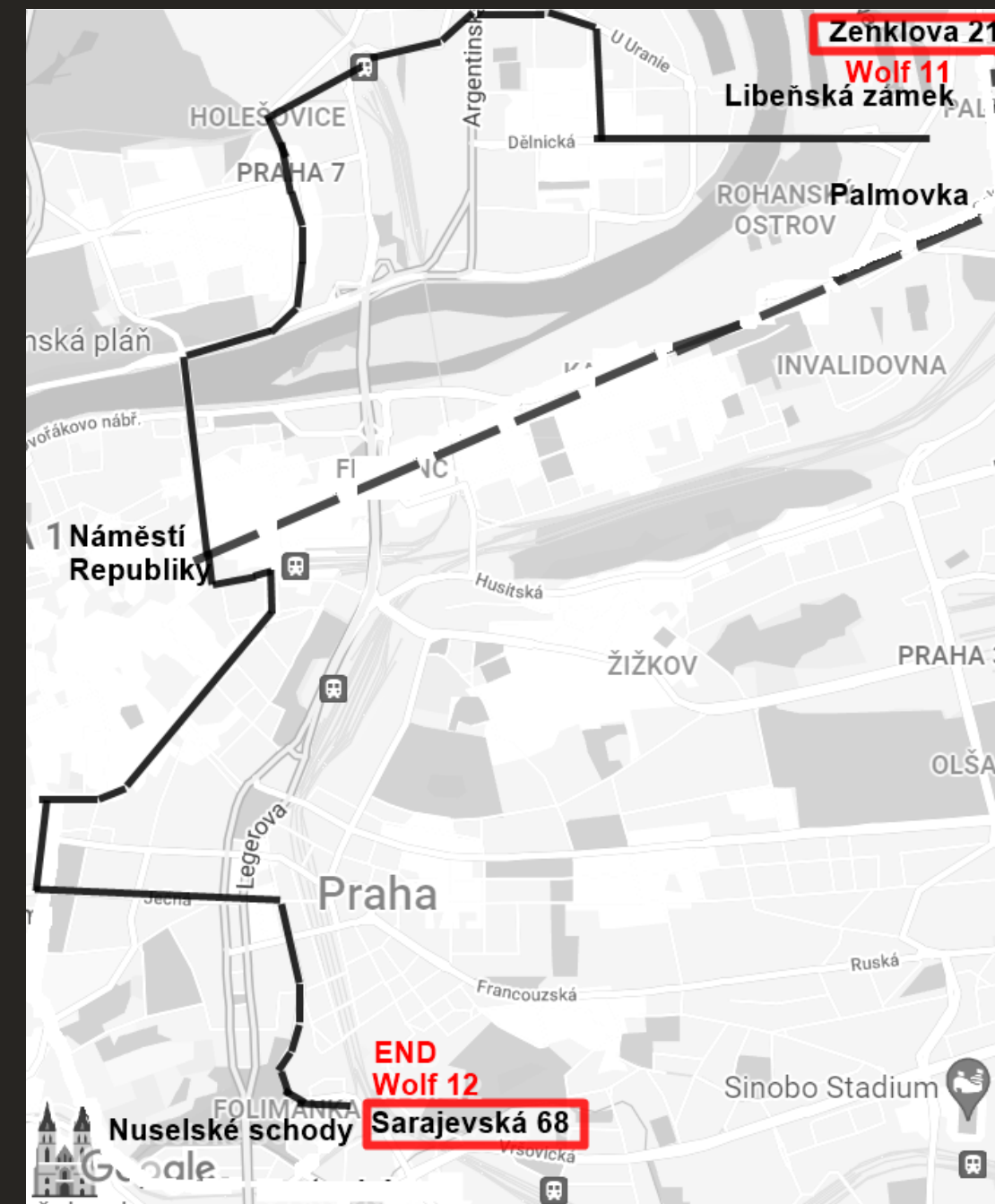
Find Wolf 8 in the foyer of the National Technical Library at Technická 2710.

Return to Lotyšská tram stop and take a tram 8 (direction Starý Hloubětín) to Letenské náměstí station, walk via Ovenceká, Letohradská and Muzejní to Kostelní.

Find Wolf 9 in the National Museum of Agriculture at Kostelní 44.

Return to Letenské náměstí tram stop and take a tram 8 (direction Starý Hloubětín) or tram 26 (direction Nádraží Hostivař) to Náměstí Republiky.

Find Wolf 10 in the underpass of Náměstí Republiky metro station.



Take metro from Náměstí Republiky (direction Černý Most) to Palmovka station, walk via Zenklova.

Find Wolf 11 in Česká Spořitelna at Zenklova 21.

From Zenklova street, walk back to Palmovka and turn into Libeňský most. At this Palmovka tram stop, take tram 6 (direction Vozovna Strašnice) to the Nuselské schody tram stop. Walk via Bělehradská, Fričova.

Find the last Wolf 12 in Etc. Gallery** at Sarajevská 68.
